Attached you will find The Brandeis School Reopening Plan that was submitted to The New York State Department of Health and Education Department. Please set aside some time to review it carefully.

Additionally, below you will find important health and safety information.

Travel Advisory:

In order to ensure the safety of our students and staff members, we ask you to carefully review the NY State Travel Advisory below. Any families traveling to any of the states listed MUST self-quarantine for 14 days when returning to New York while this advisory remains in effect. Students who have traveled to any of these locations must self quarantine for 14 days beginning no later than August 24th. Students who traveled and have not quarantined will not be allowed on campus.

Lice Check:

Lice check will take place on the first day of school for all Brandeis students. Before bringing your child(ren) to school, please set aside some time to administer your own lice check at home. Immunizations:
